No action or discussion may be undertaken by the Senior Community Commission on any item if not posted on the Agenda, except that Commissioners or staff may briefly respond to statements made or questions posed by the public, or a Commissioner or staff liaison may ask a question for clarification, or make a brief report on his or her own activities. A Commissioner or the Commission itself may provide a reference to staff to report back to the Commission at a subsequent meeting concerning any matter or may direct staff to place a matter of business on a future agenda.
