Highlights:

- On Wednesday, April 23 a representative from DMV Senior Ombudsman Program spoke to 22 seniors about maintaining their driving independence, different types of DMV resources available to them, and addressed concerns of senior drivers.
- April Activities included the dyeing of eggs and creating tissue paper flower bouquets on Thursday,
 April 17. All seniors were able to take eggs and flowers home.
- Movies shown in April were "Gravity" on April 2 and "The Iron Lady" on April 16. Due to electrical
 problems on April 2, the movie was postponed to June; twelve were in attendance for the movie on
 April 16. Participants continue to like viewing the movies at the Senior Center.
- As of Tuesday, April 22 the Hawaiian and Polynesian Dance class has a new instructor, Barbara Dempsey, who has over 15 years of dance experience and currently teaches at the La Canada Flintridge Community Center. The numbers continue to grow for this class.
- On Thursday, April 24th five attended the monthly Brain Games Seminar hosted by ComForcare.

Updates:

- Excursions: Twenty-eight are currently enrolled for the May 16th trip to the Reagan Library, eight are enrolled for the June 20th trip to the Aquarium of the Pacific.
- The Senior Master Plan Committee met on Monday, April 7 to review the initial draft of the 2014 Scorecard. They also discussed visiting Senior Centers in the area to gain further ideas for the scorecard.
- Community Yard Sale: Thirty-six vendor spaces are available between the Sierra Vista Parking lot

and basketball court at a cost of \$30 per space. Registration began on Wednesday, April 16 and nine participants have signed up. Vendor check-in will be broken up into three timeslots: 6:00am, 6:15am, and 6:30am. Staff is recruiting girl scouts to assist vendors with unloading their vehicles in the morning. A reservation with Acts Thrift Store has been made to pick up all items at the end of the event.

 Senior Specialist Rebecca Lamas will be leaving the Senior Center and City of Sierra Madre; her last day is Thursday, May 1st. She has accepted a full time job with the State of Nebraska as a Recreation Specialist. At this time there is a general fund hiring freeze and the position will not be filled until further direction is received from City Council.

SUBJECT: REVIEW OF RESOURCE GUIDE ROUGH DRAFT

SUMMARY

The Resource Guide Ad-Hoc Committee is seeking the Senior Community Commission's feedback on the categories, contact information, layout, and format of the Resource Guide.

ANALYSIS

The Resource Guide Ad-Hoc Committee has been working for several months on compiling data to include in the upcoming Resource Guide. As there are many types of resource guides available the Committee chose to focus on resources that specifically serviced the Sierra Madre community. Attached is a rough draft of the resource guide.

Resources are listed by category (banks, florists, senior centers, etc...) and then each resource is listed alphabetically with in that category. The address, phone number, website, and email listed for each resource has been confirmed; however, not all the resources have all the contact information. Also, all resources included in the document have been confirmed to service or cater to the Sierra Madre community. The Committee anticipates printing the resource guide in a booklet format, 5.5" wide x 8.5" tall.

NEXT STEPS

Commissioners should review the rough draft of the resource guide and determine if they are in concurrence with the categories, contact information, layout and format that the Ad-Hoc Committee has developed. If Commissioners are not in concurrence with any of the components they should suggest changes.

Commissioners may want to consider the following while reviewing: appropriate category names, consistency of contact information, a descriptor sentence or paragraph at the start of each category, the size of the document, a limit to the number of pages, and font size. If Commissioners think of anything else pertinent they should share that too.

The Committee will take the suggestions of the Commission and revise the document, bringing a more formal second draft back to the Commission at a future meeting.
